#### MidYIS Test - Notice for Year 7 Parents

On Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September all Year 7 pupils will sit a computer based MidYIS test. No revision/preparation is required from the pupils in any way.

The MidYIS test is what we call a "baseline assessment", designed to measure pupils' developed ability rather than what has been taught previously in school. It gives measures of pupils' underlying potential to do well, and tests their strengths and weaknesses across four categories or sub-scales: Vocabulary, Maths, Non-verbal reasoning and Skills (including proof-reading). The focus of the MIDYIS test is to derive a sound indication of likely later academic achievement if steady progress is made, and to provide us with a baseline starting point for each student. Many secondary schools countrywide give students some sort of a baseline assessment to their Year 7s on entry.

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
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# TUESDAY 26<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2017 INTERNATIONAL DAY DRESS UP!
