



## Sixth Form Dress Code

The dress code is designed to be as simple as possible but no list can be completely comprehensive. If in doubt about any items it will be necessary before making a purchase to consult with the Director of Sixth Form Studies, whose decision is final.

Hairstyles should not include any motifs and should be in natural hair colours. Beards and moustaches should be kept short and tidy.

### Dress Code ~ Girls

#### EITHER

##### (a) Suit

Jacket and skirt/trousers of a formal cut, in plain navy blue, dark grey or black.

Jackets to be worn:

1. to and from school; and
2. at all times in school, except at discretion of teachers during lessons and during hot weather.

Skirts must be of an appropriate length and style for school (eg not 'wrap-round' or 'mini'), and with no ornamentation

#### OR

##### (b) Dress

Dresses may be worn without a jacket and should be made of a plain black, blue or grey material, and of an appropriate length and style for school as for skirts in (a) above.

#### Shoes

These should be black and of a plain design and suitable for school. Very high or stiletto heels must not be worn. Boots or trainers may not be worn.

#### Shirt/Blouse

Any coloured/patterned shirt/blouse with sleeves or a smart plain top. No logos allowed. Polo shirts and vests are not allowed.

#### Tights/Stockings

Tights or stockings must be black or natural and must not have fancy markings.

#### Pullover/Sweater

Navy blue, grey, white or black; no logos are allowed; sweatshirts or hooded tops may not be worn.

#### Outdoor Wear

Navy blue, dark grey, or black topcoat. These should be in a simple style and without additional colours or logos. Denim material is not allowed. Leather coats are not advised as the school cannot be held responsible for loss or damage. Outdoor coats should not be worn routinely during the school day.

#### Jewellery

One plain ear stud per ear may be worn and one plain finger ring.

#### PE

Both boys and girls need to ensure that they wear a white polo shirt (plain, without motif) and either black shorts or tracksuit bottoms.

## **Dress Code ~ Boys**

### **Suit**

Suit, single or double-breasted, must be either dark blue, dark grey or black. Jackets are to be worn:

1. to and from school; and
2. at all times in school, except at discretion of teachers during lessons and during hot weather.

**NB: A combination of suit jacket and non-matching trousers is not acceptable.**

### **Tie**

Must be worn.

### **Shirt**

Shirts must be plain, any colour with short or long sleeves. No logos are allowed. Polo shirts and T-shirts are not allowed. Shirts must be tucked in.

### **Shoes**

These should be black. Boots or trainers may not be worn.

### **Socks**

Plain, navy blue, black or grey.

### **Pullover/Sweater**

Navy blue, grey or black, V-necked so that the tie is clearly visible. No logos allowed. Sweatshirts or hooded tops may not be worn.

### **Outdoor Wear**

Navy blue, dark grey, or black topcoat. These should be in a simple style and without additional colours or logos. Denim material is not allowed. Leather coats are not advised as the school cannot be held responsible for loss or damage. Outdoor coats should not be worn routinely during the school day.

### **Jewellery**

One plain ear stud per ear may be worn and one plain finger ring.

### **PE**
