66% of Subject grades were at grades 9-7 (17.6% at grade 9)

2 students achieved grade 9s in all 12 of their GCSEs. One student achieved 9s in 11 GCSEs and an A* in Maths A Level. He was the highest scoring OCR candidate in both Chemistry and Biology this year. A further 3 students achieved grade 9s in 11 of their subjects, including 9s in Further Maths GCSE. 2 students gained grade 9s in 10 of their subjects. 34 students gained all eleven of their GCSEs at grade 9-7 (18%).
