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Outstanding Outcomes



- An average point score of 34 (global average 30 points)

- 7 into Oxbridge, 12 Medics/Dentist/Vets

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The IBDP



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- IB students are:
 - Over 3 times more likely to attend a top 20 HE institution
 - 40% more likely to gain a 2:1 or 1st class degree
 - 40% more likely to do a PhD, Masters or additional degree
 - 7% more likely to earn a first-class honours degree compared to matched A level students."

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The IB Diploma: Key Points



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6 subjects:

3 at Higher Level (HL)

3 at Standard Level (SL)

Some subjects are only taught at Standard:
ESS, Chinese

Some are only available at Higher:
Film, Economics, Chemistry and Physics,
Sports Science, Computer Science



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Assessment Outline



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Six subjects; 3 HL 3 SL

Each subject is worth 7 points whether Higher or Standard.

Total of 45 points: $(6 \text{ subjects} \times 7) + 3 \text{ possible extras} = 45$

No external exams in Year 12

Exams in May of Year 13
