Some are only available at Higher: Film, Economics, Chemistry and Physics, Sports Science, Computer Science

Six subjects; 3 HL 3 SL Each subject is worth 7 points whether Higher or Standard. Total of 45 points: (6 subjects x 7) + 3 possible extras = 45

No external exams in Year 12 Exams in May of Year 13 Results on 6 July of Year 13
