

FBCS Induction activity.

Hello there, and welcome to FBCS! You may be wondering what these letters even stand for, so let me explain. FBCS stands for Faith, Beliefs, Culture and Society. In this subject, we learn about different religions, different ways of life, we look at what makes us who we are from the point of view of our culture and our identity; we also look at important social issues such as inequality (in all its forms, be it gender, race, religion etc.), human rights and migration.

In order to have a taste of what we do in FBCS, I would like you to do the following task. Think about the following questions:

Faith - do you believe in a supernatural being/a god? Are you part of a religious faith? If so, what is it and why is it important to you? If not, why not?

Belief - what are the most important beliefs you hold? These are not just religious beliefs, but also beliefs about how we should treat each other, or the environment...think about your top 3 and why do you stand by them.

Culture - in what ways do you express the culture or cultures you belong to? What kind of music, dance, clothing, food etc express who you are?

Society - what social issues are important to you? What causes do you champion? Think about your top 3 most important ones and why do you think they are important.

Having reflected on these questions, you can represent who you are and where you stand for by either:

- Drawing a poster (in which case you can draw it on paper, take a picture and insert it here)
- Writing a poem
- Writing a speech
