Dear year 10 Parent/Carer,

I wrote on 21st July informing you of arrangements for the start of the new school year. I write again with a few clarifications and reminders to ensure a smooth start for us all.

The Covid guidance for schools is considerably more relaxed than previously (see the latest <u>risk</u> <u>assessment</u> on our website) which makes it even more important that we ensure that **anyone with Covid-19 does not come into school**. There are three ways to support us in keeping the school free of infection.

- Testing please ensure that your child takes a home self-test today, using the LFD kits we distributed before we finished in the summer. We will be testing your child twice on their return to school (see below) and self-testing should then continue twice-weekly at home from the end of next week. If we can catch anyone infectious before they come into school for a test on Friday, we will have reduced the risk of spread already.
- 2. Being alert to Covid symptoms. **If your child displays Covid symptoms it is vital that you keep your child at home** and contact attendance at school in the usual way.
- 3. Ensure that your child has a face covering with them every day. Although face coverings are no longer required, there may be circumstances where we ask students to wear them for a short period of time.

The start of term arrangements are as follows:

Thursday 2nd September - test and return home

Students with consent will test in school (please arrive in school uniform) according to this timetable **and then return home** immediately. Students should bring their canteen name card, as before, to speed up the process of registering. 10JR at 10.15am 10TMR (9 RPP) at 10.30am 10LC at 10.45am 10SDA at 11.00am

10ML at 11.15am 10EAG at 11.30am

Students for whom consent has not been given will begin school on Monday as below.

Monday 6th September - Normal day but with extended form time during period 1.

Normal day in school starting promptly at **8.30 a.m. with registration** in tutor rooms as follows: 10JR in L3 10TMR (9 RPP) in M1 10LC in M22 10SDA in L13 10ML in M32 10EAG in H6

The canteen will be available as usual. Students with consent will take their second test during the day.

Thank you to everyone who completed the <u>Ofsted Parent View survey</u> - a very positive picture has emerged for us to celebrate and build upon. If you haven't yet completed the survey or a second member of your household would like to, only a unique email address is required for a very brief registration to prevent misuse.

I look forward to welcoming your child back this week.
