Praise-Emmanuel was gentle, kind and caring, with a great sense of humour. He was a bright young man who worked hard, was always smiling and was a role model for his peers around school. He was also a key member of the school football team.

Our hearts go out to Mrs Diya and her daughter who are left in an unimaginable situation. We feel bewildered and powerless in the face of this senseless tragedy. And we are left with an inexplicable gap in his form group, Emmanuel's year group and in our school community as a whole.



After Christmas, Emmanuel's friends and his Director of Study, Mr Martin, liaised with the football club, Manchester City, which Emmanuel supported so avidly. As part of the Club's memorial fixture on Sunday 29th December, when it remembered City fans who passed during the year, a minute's silence was held and Praise-Emmanuel Diya's name, along with that of his father and sister, were shown on the stadium display ribbon. Further tributes have been planned by students across the year groups which highlights the impact Emmanuel had on our school community.

Our return to school in the New Year was subdued. Year 11 joined together in an assembly first thing on Monday morning to grieve together and mourn our loss. We miss him desperately, but on Friday afternoon, we will have the opportunity to celebrate Praise-Emmanuel's life in a Memorial Assembly that a group of his friends are organising with Mr Martin, and with his senior mentor, Ms Fuwa and his form tutor, Miss Bellingham. Together - students, staff, former staff, governors, the Diya family and their friends and colleagues - we will celebrate and remember this wonderful young man and treasure the years we had with him.
