Boston Ski 2019
15th – 23rd February 2019

Traditional New Hampshire ski resort nestle in the heart of the scenic Western White Mountains. This area has dependable skiing conditions and top notch snow-making facilities. The award winning Loon Mountain is perhaps the best known resort, offering a wide range of terrain and excellent conditions. Groups will have the opportunity to ski two resorts during the week and, with the majority of hotels in the centrally located town of Lincoln, most prefer to ski Loon plus either Cannon or Waterville Valley. Experience more of the USA by adding a city stopover in Boston.

The cost of this trip is £1,476 and includes full board, ski lift pass, 5 days lessons and return travel. This is an excellent price with 4 hours of lessons per day and reserved a hotel with impressive facilities which include; an indoor swimming pool, two outdoor hot tubs, fitness room, sauna and steam room. There is also an arcade, mini-cinema and restaurant. A typical day will consist of; early breakfast 2 hours in a ski lesson with an instructor in ability groups, a hot lunch on the mountainside, and a further 2 hours of ski instruction, dinner and evening activities. Evening activities are optional and varied to include a sports event, movie night, games competition and quiz. There will be a staff ratio of 8 pupils per member of staff.

The date of the tour is the **15th – 23rd February 2019**. Above, you will see the main outline of the tour, enough I hope for you to make the commitment for your son/daughter to join if you would like them to.

Places on this trip are limited and will only be secured on a first come PAID deposit. So it is essential that you pay the initial deposit of £300 immediately online via ParentPay in order to ensure your son/daughters' place on the trip. The trip is available to all students in Years 7-11.

As with any school journey a student may be removed from the trip if they fail to meet the school's expectations with regard to behaviour, in the run up to the event. If such a situation arises it may not be possible to refund all, or any, of the monies paid depending on the deposits necessary to secure the trip and the refunds policy of companies employed on our behalf. Should you withdraw your child from the trip, all payments, including the deposit, will be non-refundable, subject to the terms of the school's travel insurance.
