





## **Adult Evening Language Classes and Private Tuition for Students/ Adults**

Our language assistants are offering online adult classes in German and Italian, as well as individual tuition on a private basis. So whether you're looking to brush up for a holiday, are looking to master the basics, fulfil a New Year's Resolution (before the year is out!) or just to get a little bit more fluency and confidence with a language you already know, there's something for you.

The beginners' adult course will commence on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> September. Depending on the uptake, there may well be an intermediate class. This will be a 12 week course for £150, from Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> September - Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December, (not including the half term Wednesday.) Bank transfers directly to the Assistants, paid prior to the first lesson, please.
