Dear Parents/Carers,

You will be pleased that the frequency of my communications has ebbed this year as Covid has retreated (although as I write, it seems the number of cases are picking up a little as we approach the summer holiday). Thank you for your support in improving **attendance and punctuality** as mentioned in my last letter and outlined by the Attendance Office more recently. We will continue to push hard to ensure that we return to pre-pandemic levels on our return in September.

Road safety outside the school is a theme, unfortunately, that I have to return to regularly. With recent induction days for our new years 7 and 12 and with occasional day trips both from BGS and from Danson Primary School involving coaches on Danson Lane, traffic has been congested sometimes.
