Congratulations to a BGS Foyle Young Poet of the Year!

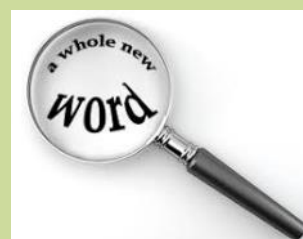
We are delighted to announce that Niamh O'Toole-MacKridge has been named as a Commended winner of the Foyle Young Poet of the Year.
