

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

We aim to encourage students to dress in a smart and professional manner in order to create a mature working environment.

We regard the uniform as an important feature of school life. Not only is it the means by which the school gives itself a collective identity, but it is also a significant criterion by which we are judged in the local community. There is little doubt that people are judged by appearances to a considerable extent; consequently, the reputation of the school can be influenced, favourably or adversely, by the way in which the students dress. It is policy to have a school uniform and all students must keep to the following regulations. These are designed to be as simple as possible but no list can be completely comprehensive. If in doubt about any items it will be necessary before making a purchase to consult with the Director of Studies, whose decision must be final.

Dress Code

- All students should be wearing a smart blazer/suit jacket at all times
- All students should be wearing either skirt suits or trouser suits with blouses or formally collared shirts
- Where a trouser suit and a formally collared shirt are worn, a tie must also be worn
- Dresses, denim and leggings are not permitted
- Trainers are not permitted
- Skirts should be knee-length and of smart appearance. Short stretchy skirts are unacceptable
- A smart jumper is optional but must be worn underneath a suit jacket; it does not replace a suit jacket or blazer
