Year 10 Mock Examinations Study leave
Monday 28th April - Wednesday 7th May 2025

I am writing to inform you that your child will have Year 10 mock examinations from Monday 28th April to Wednesday 7th May inclusive, and will have study leave through this period so will only have to attend school for the relevant examinations during this period. All students are back in school ready to return to normal lessons on Thursday 8th May.

Each Year 10 student has already received the mock examination timetable and is aware of which sessions they need to attend. I have included a copy of the timetable with this letter for your information. They are expected to attend exams in full school uniform.

A small number of students who have yet to develop the self-discipline to benefit from study leave will be required to attend school throughout the exam period. These students will be notified separately. All students will be able to request to study in school rather than at home. Registers will be taken in the examination rooms. Any amendments/details relating to a particular day's examinations will be displayed in the canteen on that day, and will be emailed to students at the end of the previous day. Students should check both their school emails and the canteen notice board as they enter the school, each day. If your child is seriously unwell and unable to attend an exam please notify the attendance office as soon as possible and before the exam start time.

During these mocks students will be able to place their bags next to their desk in the exam hall. If students wish to use their lockers this must be done well in advance of the start of the exam. They should have a clear pencil case for all exams, and a transparent water bottle without a label. All technology (mobile phones, iPods, AirPods, earphones/earbuds, MP3/4 players or similar) must be off and in their school bags. Please note that students are also not allowed to bring a watch of any sort into the exam room and this must also be closed within their school bag.

Morning exams begin promptly at 8.30am, so students should be in school before 8.20am in order to be ready for admittance to the exam hall ahead of the beginning of the exam. Students will be reminded of all examination requirements and expectations in our year group assembly on our return to school after the Easter break.

These arrangements will also apply during study leave for the examinations in January Year 11.
